1. On Application			
1.1	Application for Enrolment	\$200	A per family non-refundable fee is required on application. Note: Application for Enrolment forms must be completed for each sibling and submitted as one transaction. If younger siblings apply for enrolment at a later stage the \$200 administration fee will once again apply.
2. On Acceptance of Offer			
2.1	Placement Fee	\$400	A non-refundable placement fee required on enrolment to confirm acceptance of the place.
2.2	Enrolment Bond - One term's fees in advance per child. This is used as a bond to protect the school from financial risk. <i>(It is not used to pay for the first term of fees).</i>	\$1,834 (early years - year 6) \$2,430 (year 7 - 9) \$2,553 (year 10-12)	This bond will be applied to any outstanding fees when a child leaves the college and is fully refundable should all fees be up-to-date and appropriate notice has been given. Note: Families with children entering the college aged from 3 years old will also be charged the enrolment bond (term in advance fees).

Term 2 Fees are payable by <u>March 29</u> . Term 3 Fees are payable by <u>June 14</u> . Term 4 Fees are payable by <u>September 13</u> .
3.3	Primary College (Prep* - Year 6) <i>Tuition Fees</i> Per Term (4 terms per year) Per Annum *Prep age is turning 5 years old by 30th June that year.	\$1,834 \$7,336	Tuition fees are due for 2019. Term 1 Fees are payable by <u>February 1</u> . Term 2 Fees are payable by <u>March 29</u> . Term 3 Fees are payable by <u>June 14</u> . Term 4 Fees are payable by <u>September 13</u> . Tuition fees include tuition, all Montessori educational materials, junior and senior camp, most excursions and co-curricular subjects such as sport, music, languages and drama. Students in the primary college are not required to supply any textbooks or stationery.

3.7	Pro Rata Status		Tuition fees only will be prorated where a student commences during the term. All other fees including levies are not prorated. Note: Students starting mid-week will be invoiced for the entire week.
3.8	Notice period required		The college requires one full term's notice in writing before the withdrawal of a student or one full term's Tuition Fees will be payable in lieu of notice. <u>To leave at the end of Term 2, 2019</u> notice is required by Friday 29th March 2019 . <u>To leave at the end of Term 3, 2019</u> notice is required by Friday 14th June 2019 . <u>To leave at the end of Term 4, 2019</u> notice is required by Friday 13th September 2019 . <u>To leave at the end of Term 1, 2020</u> notice is required by Friday 29th November 2019.

4.1	Senior Phase Camps	\$1,200 (approx)	Students in the Senior Phase will be charged the cost of their accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.
4.2	Adolescent Odyssey Expedition	\$1,200 (approx)	Children in the Adolescent Community will be charged the cost of their accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.
4.3	Senior Primary Canberra Trip	\$1,500 (approx)	Children in Year 6 will be charged the cost of their flight, accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.

4.4	Excursions & Going Outs	Pay as you go	For Senior Phase, Adolescent Community, Senior and Junior Primary students. As required, these excursions are to be paid for online and prior to the date of event.
4.5	National Testing	\$28	This fee applies to children and adolescents in years 3, 5, 7 and 9 and is the administration fee charged by the government to administer national testing.
4.6	Learning Engagement & Enrichment	\$0	Diagnostic assessments and individualised support material help to provide a clear direction for effective teaching and explicit support practices for LE students.
4.7	(a) School-based internal assessments	\$0 - \$75	Verified testing materials will be billed to parents as required.
	(b) School-based External assessments provided by psychologist, etc.	\$380 - \$420	Any external assessments are the responsibility of the parents and will be paid directly to the assessment provider. External funding may be available through Allied Health plans, insurance providers and various community groups and agencies.
	(c) External assessment and support programs	\$50 - \$1,500 (approx.)	Any external assessments or support programs are the responsibility of the parents and will be paid directly to the provider. External funding may be available through Allied Health plans, insurance providers and various community groups and agencies.
	(d) Individualised support materials or equipment	\$5 - \$250 (approx.)	Individual support materials or equipment will be billed to the parent as required.

6.	Discounts		
6.1	Tuition fees in advance.	5%	Annual tuition fee payments attract a 5% discount. These tuition fee payments are paid in advance and are due on the last day of the first week of Term 1. i.e. annual

			tuition fees for 2019 are due and payable on Friday, 1st February, 2019.
6.2	Sibling Discount for Third Child	20%	A 20 % reduction in tuition fees is applied to the third child enrolled in the college. Note: The sibling discount does not apply to payment of levies.

- **Late fee:** A \$50.00 late fee is applied to outstanding balances paid after the due date.
- **GST:** All fees are inclusive of GST
- **Annual Fee Increases:** Tuition fees, as per college policy are subject to an annual increase of 8% – 12%.
- **Terms and Conditions:** In the ordinary course of business, fees are adjusted annually at the beginning of each calendar year. The board reserves the right to vary fees at other times during the year.

The college provides two options for payment of Tuition fees:

1. Term fees to be paid by **DUE DATE each term** by Cash/Cheque/Credit Card/Direct Deposit **OR**
2. Term fees to be paid by instalments via the College's **Direct Debit facility** from your nominated bank account or credit card to ensure the total tuition fees are paid by no later than 1 December each year.
