1 On Application			
1.1	<b>Application for Enrolment</b>	\$200	A per family <b>non-refundable</b> fee is required on application. <b>Note:</b> Application for Enrolment forms must be completed for each sibling and submitted as one transaction. If younger siblings apply for enrolment at a later stage the \$200 administration fee will once again apply.
2. On Acceptance of Offer			
2.1	<b>Placement Fee</b>	\$400	A <b>non-refundable</b> placement fee required on enrolment to confirm acceptance of the place.
2.2	<b>Enrolment Bond - One term's fees per child.</b> This is used as a bond to protect the school from financial risk. <i>(It is not used to pay for the first term of fees or the last term of fees prior to leaving the College).</i>	\$2,015 (Early Learning)  \$2,015 (Prep–Year 6)  \$2,628 (Year 7–10)  \$2,761 (Year 11–12)	The bond is <b>fully refundable</b> should all fees be up-to-date and appropriate notice has been given.  <b>Note:</b> Families with students entering the College aged from 3 years old will also be charged the enrolment bond (one term's fees).

3.7	<p><b>Pro Rata Status</b></p>		<p>Tuition fees only will be prorated where a student commences during the term. All other fees including levies are not prorated.</p> <p>Note: Students starting mid-week will be invoiced for the entire week.</p>
3.8	<p><b>Notice period required</b></p>		<p>The College requires one full term’s notice in writing before the withdrawal of a student or one full term’s Tuition Fees will be payable in lieu of notice.</p> <p><b>To leave at the end of Term 2, 2022</b> notice is required by Friday 25th March 2022.</p> <p><b>To leave at the end of Term 3, 2022</b> notice is required by Friday 10th June 2022.</p> <p><b>To leave at the end of Term 4, 2022</b> notice is required by Friday 9th September 2022.</p> <p><b>To leave at the end of Term 1, 2023</b> notice is required by Friday 25th November 2022.</p>

4 Other fees and charges			
4.1	<b>Adolescent Community (Year 11 – Year 12)</b>	\$1,200 (approx)	Students in the Adolescent Community (Year 11 - Year 12 couplet) will be charged the cost of their accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.
4.2	<b>Adolescent Community Odyssey Expedition (Year 7, 8, 9 and 10)</b>	\$1,200 (approx)	Students in the Adolescent Community (Year 7 - Year 8 and Year 9 - Year 10 couplets) will be charged the cost of their accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.
4.3	<b>Senior Primary Canberra Trip</b>	\$1,500 (approx)	Students in Year 6 will be charged the cost of their flight, accommodation and associated travel. Payments can be paid via a pre arranged instalment plan.
4.4	<b>Excursions &amp; Going Outs</b>	Pay as you go	For Adolescent Community, Senior and Junior Primary students. As required, these excursions are to be paid for online and prior to the date of event.
4.5	<b>National Testing</b>	\$20	This fee applies to students in years 3, 5, 7 and 9 and is the administration fee charged by the government to administer national testing.
4.6	<b>Community Levy (voluntary contribution) Per terms 1 &amp; 2 (per family)</b>	\$25	\$25 per terms 1 & 2 per family. This fee is used to provide community events. Should you wish not to participate please contact Accounts to have the charge reversed.
4.7	<b>Montessori Training Levy</b>	\$50	\$50 per family per annum (Term 4) assists the College in subsidising staff to complete specific Montessori training programs over and above their teaching professional development.

5 Levies			
5.1	<b>Building and Land Levy</b>	The Building and Land Levy is invoiced per term. The levy applies to every child and contributes to the development costs associated with building the new campus.

5.2	<b>Energy Levy</b>	<p>\$225 per term <b>or</b> families are able to donate 5 hours of their 'energy' and services per term.</p> <p>Participation may include: Classroom support Class Ambassador Maintenance/working bees</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Families who are unable to donate 5 hours of their 'energy' in a term will be invoiced \$225</p>	
6 Discounts			
6.1	<b>Tuition Fees in Advance</b>	2.5%	Annual tuition fee payments attract a 2.5% discount. These tuition fee payments are paid in advance and are due on the last day of the first week of Term 1. i.e. annual tuition fees for <b>2022</b> are due and payable on Friday 28th January 2022.
6.2	<b>Sibling Discount for Third Child</b>	20%	<p>A 20% reduction in tuition fees is applied to the third child enrolled in the College.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> The sibling discount does not apply to payment of levies.</p>

- + **Late fee:** A \$50.00 late fee is applied to outstanding balances paid after the due date.
